The Computer Entertainment Supplier's Association (CESA; Chairman: Shin Unozawa; Location: Minato-ku, Tokyo), in cooperation with Nikkei Business Publications, Inc. (Nikkei BP; President & CEO: Kohei Osada; Location: Minato-ku, Tokyo), will hold the "TOKYO GAME SHOW 2012" over a four-day period from Thursday, September 20 to Sunday, September 23, 2012 under the theme of "Spreading Smiles through Games." The first two days of the show (Sep. 20 & 21) will be "Business Days" for the relevant parties in the game industry while the later two days (Sep. 22 & 23) will be "Public Days."

Exhibitors of the TOKYO GAME SHOW 2012 are from 19 different countries and regions, including Japan, and the total number of exhibitors is 209 corporations and organizations (126: domestic, 83: overseas). The total number of booths is 1,609. A record number of 1,043 titles applied for exhibition.
