TOKYO GAME SHOW 2024 Online Report Official Programs Attracted 15,962,811 Views in Total

TGSDW2024 Welcomed 117,090 Visitors

Computer Entertainment Supplier's Association ("CESA", Chairperson: Haruhiro Tsujimoto) held TOKYO GAME SHOW 2024 (TGS2024) in person at Makuhari Messe, starting from September 26 (Thu.) to 29 (Sun.) Today, we have released the final number of viewers and visitors who attended the main online programs of TGS2024.

At TGS2024, a record-high 985 companies and organizations participated in the event. The physical exhibition used the entire Makuhari Messe building as the venue. The online programs included the official program streaming, the virtual exhibition TOKYO GAME SHOW Digital World 2024 (TGSDW2024), and the Steam Special Site, making it the largest hybrid event to date in TGS history.

The official online programs that started since TGS 2020 were distributed across various platforms, including the TGS official YouTube channel, X account, niconico, and TGS Special page on Steam. For China, the programs were distributed on video platforms such as DouYu and bilibili. TGS partnered with IGN, one of the world's largest gaming media, to distribute programs in Europe and the United States. Most of the programs were available in both English and Japanese with simultaneous interpretation and subtitles. Some programs were also streamed with simultaneous interpretation in Chinese, attracting many viewers from overseas. The total number of views for both live and archived distributions was 15,962,811 (period: Sep. 26 to Oct. 7).

TGSDW2024, a virtual version of the exhibition, opened on Sep. 20 (Fri.) and ran for 17 days until Oct. 6 (Sun.) The event was set on "Game Island," a virtual island floating in the sky. Visitors were able to explore the world of games, enjoy quests and magic, and visit corporate booths while traveling around the venue. The event attracted many participants, with a total number of visitors counted at 117,090 and an average stay time of approximately 77 minutes.

The next TOKYO GAME SHOW 2025 will take place from Sep. 25 (Thu.) to 28 (Sun.), and the physical location for the event will be Makuhari Messe. Stay tuned for updates on the constantly evolving event.
